

2023 Tuesday 9-Hole League Format and Procedural Rules

Match play in which two players from a team compete against two other players from another team.

<i>Play Start Date:</i>	Tuesday April 25 th , 2023
<i>Play End Date:</i>	~End of August 2023

Round-Robin Format:

- Teams are grouped into two divisions: Gold Division and White Division. Teams will only play within their respective division.
- The season will be divided into 5 Round-robin (RR) segments, each RR being three weeks long, followed by a championship tournament that will be held the last 3 weeks of the season.
- Format: 56 total teams.
 - Gold Division (teams 1-28); White Division (teams 29-56). These teams will play within their respective division.
 - 15 weeks of regular season play will consist of Five 3-week round-robin segments.
 - Championship Tournament will be held over weeks 17, 18, & 19: Top Eight teams from each division will play in the tournament.
 - During each 3-week Round-robin segment: your team will be placed in a group with three other teams, and weather permitting, your team will play each of those teams once in a head-to-head matchup. Dwan Match Points scoring (see next section) will be employed.
 - For Example:
 - Round Robin One (Weeks 1-3): Teams 1, 2, 3, & 4 will be in the same group, & they will only play each other.
 - Round Robin Two (Weeks 4-6): Teams 1, 8, 15, & 22 will be in the same group, & they will only play each other.



Scoring:

- **Dwan Match Points:** Points Allocation for Head-to-Head Matchup:
 - 2 points per individual per hole won
 - 1 point for each hole tied
 - 0 points for a hole lost
 - 2 points for winning the 9-hole match, and 1 point for a tied match.
 - All points totaled will/must equal 20.
 - The team that accumulates the most Dwan match points over the series of matches within each round robin bracket will be the winner of that bracket. The same cumulative match point totals will determine which teams finish in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th positions for that round-robin.
 - See an example of the Round Robin/Dwan Match Point standings on the last page.
- **Season Long Points (SLP):** Earning spots in the 8-team season ending playoff tournament for both the Gold and White Divisions will be based on a system called Season Long Points.
 - At the end of each round robin bracket sequence, teams will be ranked 1st through 4th.
 - The 1st place winning team will receive 6 Season Long Points, the 2nd place team receives 4 Season Long Points, the 3rd place team receives 2 SLP's, and no points are assigned to the 4th place team.
 - Should there be ties for any of the first three places, tiebreaker is the head-to-head match result; the team that won the head-to-head matchup will be awarded the higher place, points & payout. If the head-to-head match was a tie, then points will be split.
 - See an example of the SLP standings on the last page.



Playoffs and Seedings:

- The 8 teams finishing with the most Season Long Points in each division will qualify for the season ending Championship playoffs and seeded accordingly (1st plays 8th, 2nd plays 7th, etc.) Breaking ties for the 8th spot or any other seeding will be decided using the tie breaker system explained in the handbook (posted on the web site).
- Playoffs are single elimination with a consolation bracket for 1st round losers. Payouts will go to the league champions, runners-up, third place team and consolation winner. **NOTE:** No subs are permitted for teams competing in the Championship Playoffs.
- **Consolation Event for teams not making the playoffs:**
 - Teams in each division that do not qualify for the playoffs will participate in consolation events on Week 1 & 2 of the playoffs. It will be a 2-man best ball event, with payouts to the top three placing teams in each division.

Payouts:

- The available funds for payouts will be allocated between playoffs and round robin winners.
- Each round robin bracket winning team will receive a payout. At the end of each three-week sequence there will be 14 winning teams, 7 in each division. Over the course of the season, there will be 70 round robin bracket winners, meaning your team could potentially win multiple times.
- Generally, payouts to winners will be accumulated and paid out three times during the season, at the end of RR 3, the end of RR 5, and after the playoffs and consolation events.
- Prize money won on the league will be equally divided up amongst all members of the team.



Weather-related Issues:

- Should any week of RR play be cancelled for weather or course conditions, that round robin sequence will be decided based on the weeks of golf that are played, meaning a round robin might be decided based on one or two weeks of play. This is not ideal or desirable, but it is necessary because there are no open dates for make-up rounds. It is the same for all teams.
- Should weather cause the permanent suspension of a round already in progress, all incomplete matches or RR brackets will be cancelled. If both matches in a round robin bracket have been completed, those results will count. The fact that completed matches may count while suspended matches don't does not impact Season Long Points because the points are only calculated inside each individual bracket.
- The Dwan course management is the ultimate determiner of whether play is permitted or suspended.

No shows:

- Should teams or individual players fail to appear for a match, the scoring system listed in the Dwan handbook will apply. See the handbook for more specifics.
- Teams compete with the understanding that green fees are due to be paid to Dwan each week for two players per team, and teams are responsible for payments to Dwan to cover the greens fees for no shows.

Score Reporting:

- Record your gross score for every hole on the Dwan scorecard, along with your full name and Team # legibly.
 - It is not required to put your handicaps down or determine points scored etc. It is ok if you wish to do so.
- A drop box will be available to turn in your scorecards; Both teams must submit their scorecard in the drop box. Please do not leave the golf course without submitting your teams' scorecard.
- We (using Golf Genius software) will tabulate the scores and your scores will be automatically updated to GHIN; you will not need to enter your score manually in GHIN.
- Results will be published via email and posted on the website in short order.

Pace of Play: Completing twilight matches in good light requires that all Tuesday League participants play at a brisk pace of play. Please do your part to ensure rounds of 2:00 hours or less. Be on your starting tee on time and keep pace with the group in front of you!!
